OUR MISSION

OUR GOALS

- To teach our students how to properly read and recite the Quran using the rules of tajweed.
- To empower our students with an understanding of the Quran and its application with which they will be able to lead an Islamic way of life.
- To provide instruction in the memorization of Quran.
- To teach a holistic Islamic Studies curriculum including, but not limited to, Aqeedah, Seerah, Fiqh, and Hadith.
- To increase awareness of the rights, duties, and responsibilities of citizenship.

GENERAL SERVICES

- Congregational prayers and services for five daily prayers, Jumu'ah, Taraweeh, and both Eid holidays.
- After school Quran reading, memorizing, and Islamic Studies classes.
- Weekend Quran reading, memorizing, and Islamic Studies classes.
- Summer intensive featuring Quran & Islamic Studies classes, youth activities and enrichment, field trips, and community gatherings.

SOCIAL SERVICES

- The Center provides financial assistance to needy families.
- Subsidized tuition fees for underprivileged students.
- Support and education for new Muslims.

FUTURE PLANS

Our long-term plans include having a full-time boarding school and research institution that offers a Hizf program coupled with a general studies curriculum.
